1. Keep margins of 0.8 inches from top, bottom, left and right
2. **Title:** Times New Roman font, 14pt, **Bold**, Single-spacing, 12pt spacing between the Title and Authors. Maximum 20 words in the Title.
3. **Author details:** Times New Roman font, 11pt, Regular, Single-spacing, 12pt spacing before and after author details.
4. **Affiliation details:** Times New Roman font, 9pt, Regular, Single spacing, No space between the different affiliations
5. **Abstract title:** Times New Roman font, 11pt, All Caps, Single-spacing, 12pt spacing before and after author details.
6. **Abstract:** Times New Roman font, 11pt, Regular, Single-spacing, 12pt spacing before and after the abstract.
7. **Keywords:** Times New Roman font, 11pt, Regular, Single-spacing, 12pt spacing before and after the abstract. Include maximum of 05 keywords in alphabetical order. Separate the key words using a semi colon (;).
8. Please enter the corresponding author's email address after the keywords.
